



Here is a list of items campers will need to bring with them.

1. One pair of riding boots or paddock boots that have at least a ¼ flat heel. See tack shops list below. Some available to borrow if need be. You may also find used equipment on BayEquest.com
2. A riding helmet. See tack shop lists below. Some items are available to borrow if necessary.
3. Students should wear long jeans or breeches for riding and any sleeved shirt. Short sleeves are ok.
4. Knee hi socks are recommended to avoid chafing from the stirrup leathers.
5. Students should bring snacks, a lunch and a water bottle.
6. Sunscreen is highly recommended as well as a hat for when they are not riding.
7. A change of clothes is recommended as we turn on the sprinklers if it gets really hot.
8. A smile and a willingness to have fun!
